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NOTIFICATIONS BY GOVERNMENT

ENERGY DEPARTMENT

Implementation of Power Supply to Agricultural Services

[G.O.Ms.No.71, Energy (C3), 25th July 2006.]

No.II(2)/EGY/422/2005.—Whereas the preamble to the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) inter-alia contemplates supply of electricity to all areas;

And whereas the Government of Tamil Nadu are under the statutory obligation to supply electricity to all areas including villages and hamlets as enjoined under Section 6 of the said Act:

And whereas most of the agriculturists are earning their livelihood only in rural areas consisting of villages and hamlets wherein the agricultural lands from which they carry on their livelihood situate:

And whereas under Section 5 of the said Act, it is the Central Government, which in consultation with the State Governments and the State Commissions, have to formulate a National Policy for Rural Electrification and for bulk purchase of power and management of local distribution in rural areas through panchayat Institutions, User Associations, Cooperative Societies, Non-Governmental Organisations or franchisees;

And whereas the question of supply of electricity to egriculturists by the Distribution Licensees in the State of Tamil Nadu within one month after receipt of the applications made in this behalf by the agriculturists under sub-section (1) of Section 43 of the said Act largely and mostly depends upon the decision to be taken by the Government of Tamil Nadu and that it is not practicable for the Distribution Licensees in the State of Tamil Nadu to comply with the mandatory provisions contained in sub-section (1) of Section 43 of the said Act, in so far as the agriculturists are concerned;

And whereas under Section 65 of the said Act, the Government of Tamil Nadu have to bear the subsidy towards the supply of electricity to the agriculturists in certain cases when the Government of Tamil Nadu feel that as necessary on socio economic considerations;

And whereas the Government of Tamil Nadu, in public interest, are also obliged to monitor and control the drawal of ground water within the acceptable limits in specified areas and are bound to regulate such drawal on various other considerations such as ecological and environmental factors, it has become absolutely necessary to restrict the number of agricultural services and the supply of electricity to the agriculturists in public interest;

And whereas in order to achieve the above purpose, it has become necessary to give suitable directions to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission to incorporate suitable provisions in the Regulations including Electricity Supply Code to be framed by the said Commission under the said Act to provide electricity supply to agriculturists, in consultation with Government of Tamil Nadu in terms of

Section 53 of the said Act and with the prior approval of the Government of Tamil Nadu in terms of Section 58 of the said Act;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 108 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003), the Governor of Tamil Nagu hereby gives the following directions, namely:—

The Tamil Nadu State Electricity Regulatory Commission while making Regulations including Electricity Supply Code under the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) shall incorporate suitable specific provision in the said Regulations including the said Code that extension of services under the Agricultural category shall be governed by the directions of the Government of Tamil Nadu from time to time.
